

Medicare's annual open enrollment period to select coverage for 2025 is Oct. 15 to <u>Dec. 7</u>

The Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program (OSHIIP), the state's official Medicare education, plan comparison, and enrollment assistance program, is holding free and unbiased virtual and statewide in-person Medicare Check-up events around the Medicare annual open enrollment period, which runs Oct. 15 to Dec. 7.

OSHIIP, funded in part by Medicare, is a longtime unbiased resource that helps Ohioans navigate Medicare. Each year, OSHIIP assists thousands of Ohioans save money through such means as careful coverage evaluation and financial assistance identification.

During the event, participants will learn Medicare fundamentals and can make an appointment to meet with an OSHIIP counselor for help with plan comparison and enrollment (after October 15).


